Grad Requirements: Grades 10 - 12

To graduate, you need at least 48 credits from Required Courses – subjects such as Language Arts, Social Studies, Science and Math. As well, you need 28 credits from Elective Courses

Note:

- All ministry-authorized and board/authority-approved courses count for credit. Locally developed – do not count for credit.
- Minimum of 16 credits at the Grade 12 level including Language Arts 12.
- Fine Arts or Applied Skills 10, 11 or 12.
- Eighty credits minimum in Grades 10 – 12 (equivalent to 20 four-credit courses) are required for graduation.

Don't forget that post-secondary institutions often require you to complete specific courses to get into certain programs. Careful planning in Grades 10, 11 and 12 will ensure you have all the courses and credits you need.
